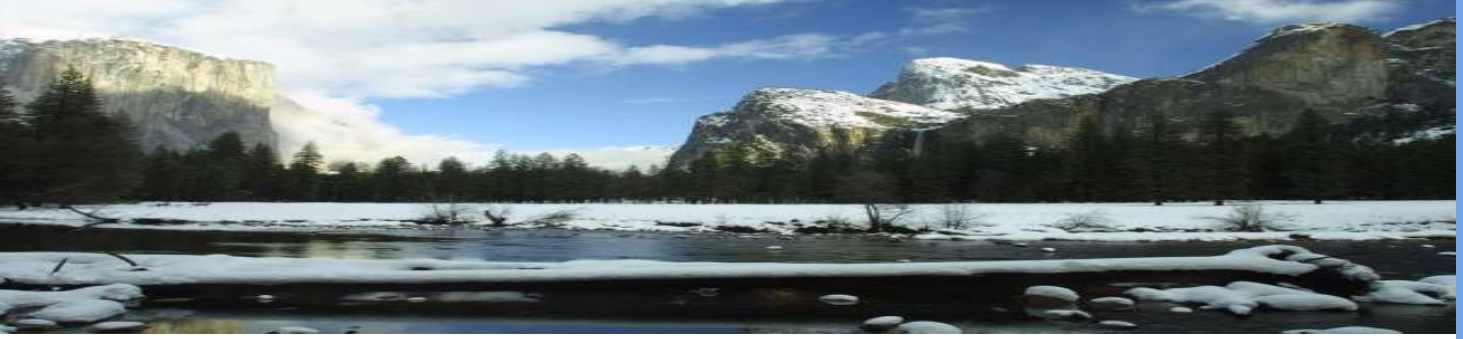
PS: As promised, since version 0.0.3 PDF Clown has supported **embedded latin OpenFont/TrueType and non-embedded Type 1 fonts** along with **paragraph construction facilities** through the BlockComposer class.

Since version 0.0.4 the content stream stack has been completed, providing **fully object-oriented access to the graphics objects that describe the contents on a page**. It's a great step towards a whole bunch of possibilities, such as text extraction/replacement, that next releases will progressively exploit.

Since version 0.0.6 it has supported **Unicode** for OpenFont/TrueType fonts.
